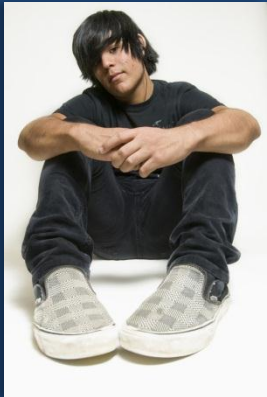

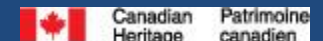

The C3 site strives

- 1) to provide creative resources for **teachers to guide** students through tasks using the writing and production processes. Teachers may map out a path or paths through the site that will lead the students to accomplish assigned tasks.
- 2) to enable **teachers to support** students and provide differentiated possibilities for writing and production. Teachers may refer students to the possibilities on the site, encourage experimentation and the creation of writing and production portfolios as well as using sections of the site for specific remediation.
- 3) **to encourage students** to develop their own possibilities for self-expression through writing and production activities and provide creative tools to accomplish their personal goals.



CREATE a variety of text types and media

From writing essays and reports to stories and poems, from creating multi-media posters to digital storytelling, students consult checklists and ICT resources throughout the process.



COLLABORATE far and wide

From discussion to consultation throughout the process, students are encouraged to use those around them and reach out to experts and others through ICT resources to brainstorm, revise and edit.
